OBJECTIVES OF THE AWARD

To encourage Technical Universities to enhance their performance and to serve the community and stake holders by improving the quality and maintaining standards of the programmes offered.

ELIGIBILITY

Any Technical Institutions which established by State/Central Government legislation, Deemed to be Universities (established under Section 3 of the UGC Act), Private Universities are eligible.

DETAILS OF THE AWARD

Award consists of a cash prize of Rs.1,00,000/-, a Plaque and a Citation.

Awards will be announced in the Annual convention of ISTE to be held on December every year. The Award will be presented to the winner during the inauguration of the ISTE Annual Convention.
